

**TOWN OF VANCE CREEK**  
**Late Fee Dog Ordinance**  
**ORDINANCE NO. 2017-09**

The Town Board of the Town of Vance Creek, Barron County, does hereby ordain as follows:

**Dog Licenses are due and payable after January 1 of any given year.** Because a significant number of Town of Vance Creek residents are routinely late in purchasing their annual dog licenses, and because the lateness results in a significant time commitment for the treasurer to follow up in collecting these licenses and because this entails a cost of postage, envelopes, and paper to collect these late dog or multiple dog licenses, the Town Board for the Town of Vance Creek does hereby approve the following ordinance, effective with its publication:

Any Town of Vance Creek resident required to obtain a license for a dog or multiple dogs in that resident's possession, who misses the deadline (March 31) of any current year shall be assessed a late fee of \$10.00 per license in addition to the regular dog license plus the Barron County Late fee of \$ 5.00 per license.

All persons shall be required to prove that their dogs have the current rabies shots to obtain their dog licenses.
