DOG ORDINANCE

Ordinance 2020-1

Dog licenses for each calendar year are due and payable after January 1 of any given year for all dogs older than 4 months of age. All persons shall be required to prove that their dogs have the current rabies shots to obtain their dog licenses.

Barron County sets a current license fee of which each municipality retains \$0.25 per license which does not cover the cost of processing and mailing of that license.

Therefore, effective as of licensing year 2021, the license fee for dogs tagged in the Town of Vance Creek will be increased by **\$2.00 for each individual spayed/neutered/intact dog and \$5.00 for each multiple dog license above the current license fee set by Barron County.** These additional funds will be used to help offset the cost of processing and mailing of the dog tags.

Additionally, any Town of Vance Creek resident required to obtain a license for a dog or multiple dogs in that resident's possession who misses the March 31 deadline of any current year shall be assessed a late fee of \$15.00 per license as outlined in the September 12, 2017 Vance Creek Dog Ordinance.
