An Ordinance

PROHIBITING DEPOSIT OF RUBBISH AND STONES ON TOWN ROAD RIGHT OF WAY

The Town Board of the Town of Vance Creek, County of Barron, State of Wisconsin do ordain as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to throw or deposit any weeds, sod, brush, cans, glass, gravel, stones, and boulders. Machinery, garbage, or other waste or rubbish in or on the right of way of any town road located in the Town of Vance Creek, Barron County, State of Wisconsin.

Section 2. Landowners will be responsible for removal of stones and debris in ditches adjacent to their property. If stones and debris are not removed, the Town will remove said debris and charge the landowner for removal according to time taken and equipment used for the removal.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after one week from the date of passage and posting is filed in the town records by the Town Clerk.

The foregoing ordinance was adopted at a regular meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Vance Creek on July 1, 1985.
